To Adopt the
**SAN MATEO COUNTY HARBOR DISTRICT POLICY 3.2 AS REVISED,
ENSURING COMPLIANCE WITH THE CALIFORNIA BROWN ACT,
PROMOTING TRANSPARENCY AND PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT**

Whereas, the State of California enacted Government Code, Chapter 9, Sections 54950-54963 to regulate the conduct of the meetings of local agencies; and

Whereas, the California Legislature found and declared "that the public commissions, boards and councils and the other public agencies in this State exist to aid in the conduct of the people's business. It is the intent of the law that their actions be taken openly and that their deliberations be conducted openly." (GC §54950); and

Whereas, the chapter is known as the Ralph M. Brown Act; and

Whereas, the District is committed to transparency and encouraging public participation in all activities the District performs, and

Whereas, the District is dedicated to ensuring compliance with the Brown M. Brown Act,

Whereas, the public or other interested parties are invited to attend all public meetings of the legislative body,

Whereas, the public or other interested parties are encouraged to make public comments at each public meeting,

Whereas, each agenda will be posted in accordance with the Brown Act, ensuring public awareness of the issues being discussed by the legislative body.

Now, Therefore, be it resolved that the Board of Harbor Commissioners adopts Resolution 23-02, approving the Policy 3.2, as revised, Brown Act Compliance Public Meetings.
