

Resolution No. 22-11
of the
San Mateo County Harbor District
to
Adopt the Preliminary Budget for Fiscal Year 2022/23
Operating Budget and Five-Year Capital Improvement Program

Whereas, §6093, §6093.1, §6093.2, and §6093.3 of the California Harbors and Navigation Code provides procedures for “Adoption of Preliminary and Final Annual Operating and Capital Budget by the San Mateo County Harbor District”; and

Whereas, the Board of Harbor Commissioners desires to adopt the Preliminary Fiscal Year 2022/23 budget in accordance with the Harbors and Navigation Code; and

Whereas, the Board of Harbor Commissioners of the San Mateo County Harbor District must set a time and place for the public hearing on the adoption and fixing of a Final Fiscal Year 2022/23 Budget.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Harbor Commissioners of the San Mateo County Harbor District does hereby adopt the Preliminary Budget as contained in the budget document attached and incorporated by reference as part of this Resolution; and which further reflects revisions and amendments, if any, as approved by this Commission; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that after publication of notice, the Board of Harbor Commissioners will meet on June 15, 2022, for the purpose of hearing from any taxpayer wishing to appear and be heard regarding budget items, after which the Board of Harbor Commissioners may amend and approve the final budget.
