Ordinance Code Section 3.7.4 Repairing Vehicles, Vessels, or Trailers Prohibited

Whereas, the San Mateo County Harbor District and its staff are vested with the responsibility to prevent pollutants from entering our valued water resources;

Whereas, the San Mateo County Harbor District has determined that District staff must have the ability to cite individuals working on vehicles and vessels which can potentially cause pollution;

Whereas, the Board of Harbor Commissioners has considered Ordinance Code Section 3.7.4 stating that it is unlawful for any person to construct, cause to be constructed, repair, cause to be repaired, any vehicle, vessel, or trailer, or any part thereof upon any District facility, parking lot, or roadway without the prior written consent and authorization of the Harbormaster or his/her designee.

Therefore, be it resolved that Ordinance Code Section 3.7.4. Repairing Vehicles, Vessels, or Trailers Prohibited is hereby adopted.

San Mateo County Harbor District Ordinance Code Section 3.7.4

3.7.4 Repairing Vehicles, Vessels, or Trailers Prohibited

It shall be unlawful for any person to construct, cause to be constructed, repair, cause to be repaired, any vehicle, vessel, or trailer, or any part thereof upon any District facility, parking lot, or roadway, without the prior written consent and authorization of the Harbormaster or his/her designee, except to make temporary emergency repairs necessary to move the vehicle, vessel or trailer. "Repairs" include, but are not limited to: bottom cleaning; removing and/or replacing of parts; removing, replacing, and/or flushing of any fluids including oils and coolants; any activities which require jacks or jack stands; or any activities which might adversely affect the environment, public safety, and/or District Property.
