

Resolution No. 23-19

A resolution of the San Mateo County Harbor District to direct staff to initiate the process to amend the Rates and Fee Schedule for Pillar Point Harbor to Impose Fees to Offset the Cost of Implementing the Commemorative Bench Program

Whereas, the Public has expressed a desire to have access to commemorative or memorial benches and plaques at Pillar Point Harbor; and

Whereas, the Harbor Board of Commissioners desires to provide the public the opportunity to have an option to place a commemorative or memorial benches or plaques at Pillar Point; and

Whereas, the president of the Harbor Board of Commissioners created an Ad Hoc Committee to investigate and make recommendations to the Harbor Board on the possible development of a new commemorative or memorial bench/plaque program at Pillar Point Harbor, and

Whereas, the Ad Hoc Committee does recommend offering a Commemorative Bench/Plaque Program at Pillar Point Harbor; and

Whereas, the former Commemorative Bench Program at Pillar Point Harbor has not been in operation since 2014 and requires updated forms and fees to offer the program once again; and

Whereas, The District desires to impose fees to offset the costs of implementing the Commemorative Bench Program: and

Whereas, The change in the Rates and Fees must be published at least 20 days before they are effective as required by Cal. Harbor and Navigation Code Section 6070.2

Now Therefore, be it resolved, that staff shall initiate proceedings to amend Rates and Fees Schedule for Pillar Point Harbor to include fees for Commemorative Benches, Plaques, Bench Plaque Rededication, and Commemorative Bench waiting list, in the amounts of \$5,000, \$700, \$500, and \$32, respectively.

Therefore, be it further resolved, that staff will duly notice a public hearing where public comments can be heard and considered with reference to the proposed amendments to the Pillar Point Harbor Rates and Fees to include fees associated with the Commemorative Bench Program.
