## Authorize Signatures on Financial Institution Accounts and Amend Policy 4.6.2 of the San Mateo County Harbor District

**Whereas**, Policy 4.6.2 was approved November 16, 2005 based on Resolution 34-05 and changes are needed in financial institutions; and,

**Whereas**, Resolution 34-05 was approved on November 16, 2005, and changes are needed in financial institutions; and,

Whereas, said financial institution accounts are as follows:

LAIF

San Mateo County Treasurer
Unrestricted Account
Restricted Account

US Bank Operating Account Payroll Account

**Therefore, be it resolved** that the signatures (by signature stamp or live) of the persons serving the following positions:

Commissioner, and/or General Manager, and/or Director of Finance, and/or Human Resource Manager

are hereby authorized to sign under the conditions as stated in Policy 4.6.2 which shall be amended as stated below:

- 1. Signatures of any two of the above persons shall be required for transfers between financial institutions and for signing operating account checks.
- 2. Any two persons listed above can sign together, with the exception of the General Manager, Director of Finance, and Human Resource Manager.
- 3. Transfers between and among San Mateo County Harbor District accounts within the same financial institution require only one signature.

- 4. Payroll checks require only one signature.
- 5. All checks over \$10,000 for operating expense, capital project and capital outlay expenditures require two live signatures, one by a Commissioner and one by either the General Manager, Director of Finance, or Human Resource Manager.

Any checks for recurring operating expenses, such as Pacific Gas & Electric Company or the Operating Engineers Trust, whether over or under \$10,000 shall be paid pursuant to the existing Bills & Claims approval procedure.

- 6. Checks routinely issued for \$10,000 and under require one signature only.
- 7. There shall be at least one live signature on all checks.
