- Dock Maintenance
- Utility Maintenance/Upgrades
- Maintenance/Cleaning of public serving facilities
 - Parking lots
 - Restrooms
 - Trash collection

- Safety Improvements
 - Leveling of expansion joints
 - Concrete seams.
 - Signage.



San Mateo County Harbor District

The Harbor District is an Independent Multi-functional, Enterprise Special District, a political subdivision of the State of California.

As a Multi-Functional District, this District provides more then one service.

As a Enterprise District, the District delivers services that are run like a business enterprise, charging for that services provided.

Requirement



 The Harbor District is required by State Code to charge to services.

Harbors and Navigation Section 6079:

"the board shall by ordinance fix the rate of wharfage charges and other charges which are appropriate for the use of any of the facilities owned and constructed or services furnished or provided by the district."

Ordinance Code



Chapter 3.10 of the SMCHD Ordinance Code:

"the District shall establish rates and fees for the use of facilities of the District and for services performed by the District. This schedule of rates and fees will be adopted by resolution of the Board of Harbor Commissioners. It shall be the responsibility of the employees of the District or their agents to collect said fees and charges

Permit Required Chapter 5.10.010 of the SMCHD Ordinance Code

It is unlawful for any person to sell or publicly solicit for sale any merchandise within the boundaries of the District unless a permit is first obtained from the District.

Vessels within the harbor or marinas of the District shall not be used for any commercial purposes unless a permit is first obtained from the District. In the case of a commercial fishing vessel the payment of berthing fees to the District and appropriate fishing permit fees to the State of California or the U.S. Government constitutes permission to conduct commercial fishing operations, excluding any wholesale buying or retail selling of fish on

premises, which requires a commercial activity permit issued by the

District.

Current Fees:

 Lessees (Fish Buyers) pay 2.5% of gross sales for off the dock sales to non-commercial buyers.

Passenger Vessels: Pay \$2.41 per passenger. (1.6% based on \$150 tk)

HMB Kayak Company: 3% gross sales

• Restaurants: 3% to 5% gross sales
